Market performance. The foreign sell-off remains the main EGX story. Foreign investors took a combined EGP282mn net sell position, as locals continued to buy the dip, with institutions holding the lion share, EGP186mn net buyers. Yesterday's EGX30 marginal recovery was reversed, on increased foreign participation, as the blue-chip index shed 0.58. The retail dominated EGX70 continued to slide, albeit at a slower pace (-0.29%), as individuals prefer to shift their capital towards EGX30 names available on the cheap. The equal weight EGX100 lost 0.42%. The indices are now down 12.80%, 16.58%, and 14.84% y-t-d, respectively.

Turnover and flows. Despite the increased foreign participation vs. Sunday's session, EGX activity remained well below its 90-day average, at EGP771mn only. Banks completely dominated flows, grabbing a year-high 42% share of turnover, as Commercial International Bank (COMI) continued to top the activity standings, trading a staggering EGP313mn, fuelled by foreign passive outflows, closing the day -0.71%. Real estate came in second, accounting for 15% of value traded, on sustained sell-off in Talaat Moustafa Group (TMGH); EGP52mn traded, and solid turnover in EGX30 Heliopolis Housing (HELI). Non-Banking Financial Solutions finished third, as EGX30 outfits EFG Hermes (HRHO) and Citadel Capital (CCAP) traded a combined EGP28mn.

Gainers and losers. The EGX30's recent uptrend has come to an end, as the index finished today's session marginally in the red, on increased foreign outflows. MM Group (MTIE) topped the index gains at +1.80%, recovering from significant losses in recent times. The stock is still down a huge 26% y-t-d, as the risk of an EGP-devaluation looms large. Egypt Kuwait Holding EGP (EKHOA) finished second, up 1.29%, closing the gap to its USD-listing, on good volume. Madinet Nasr Housing Development (MNHD) continued to build on yesterday's gains, adding 1.19%, with the name's rights now off the market. The stock remains cheap, down 23% y-t-d. Fellow real-estate heavyweight HELI recovered partially from yesterday's heavy losses (-3.77%), up 1.09%, on EGP18mn traded. Eastern Tobacco (EAST) closed out the top gainers list, on a solid EGP20mn turnover, on local institutions' appetite. In the red, healthcare continued to suffer the impact of the foreign sell-off, with both Rameda (RMDA) and Ibnsina Pharma (ISPH) reporting heavy losses, -5.45% and -5.25%, respectively. TMGH sustained recent downtrend, -3.61%, on very good volume. Orascom Development Egypt (ORHD) followed suit, -2.44%, albeit on a relatively low volume. e-finance closed out the EGX30's worst performers, at -2.14%, reversing recent gains, on a solid EGP33mn turnover.



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

Key Indices Performance





Market Turnover (EGPmn)





Trading Activity by Investor Type





Trading Activity by Nationality




